Ministry Descriptions

0-Main Worship Service: Main weekend and/or mid-week services

1-Assimilation/Hospitality: The overall experience of church attenders, including welcoming visitors, new attender classes, first impressions, ushers, décor, bookstore and/or café.

2-Bookstore: Church bookstore and/or retail operations including scheduling, training staff and volunteers, cash management, inventory and store appearance.

3-Children's: Ministry for children including Kindergarten through 5th Grade, Sunday school and vacation bible school. May include preschool/nursery.

4-College: Ministry for college-aged students (including single and married young adults)

5-Family Life: Ministry for families with children

7-Junior High: Ministry for junior high school students grades 6-8. May be held during regular weekend service times or throughout the week

8-Married Adults: Ministry for married adults may include Sunday school, Bible studies, small groups, social events, etc.

9-Men's: Ministry for adult men of all ages (both married and single). May include Sunday school, Bible studies, small groups, social events, etc.

10-Missions-All International and Local: Includes all church missions including global and local

11-Missions-Global/International: Missions outside the US

12-Missions-Local/Urban: Missions inside the US

13-Preschool/Nursery: Ministry and childcare for children up to pre-kindergarten age.

14-Senior High: Ministry for senior high school students grades 9-12. May be held during regular weekend service times or throughout the week

15-Senior's: Ministry for senior adults. May include Sunday school, Bible studies, small groups, social events, etc.

16-Single Adults: Ministry for single adults. May include Sunday school, Bible studies, small groups, social events, etc.

17-Small Groups: Ministry of small group gatherings held outside of normal church service times including connecting people to small groups, developing group leaders and launching new groups

18-Special Events/Programs: Church special events and functions including conferences, retreats, concerts, weddings, etc.

19-Sports: Ministry of sports and athletic programs used as an outreach to individuals both within and outside the church, including leagues, tournaments, etc.

20-Student/Youth: Ministry for both Junior High School and Senior High School students combined.

21-Volunteer: Ministry of recruiting, organizing, training and coaching church volunteers

22-Women's: Ministry for adult women of all ages (both married and single). May include Sunday school, Bible studies, small groups, social events, etc.

23-Other: Any other ministry not specifically defined

24-Pastoral Care: Pastoral care ministry including all outreach/evangelism and various care programs (e.g., hospital, nursing home, and home visitations, hardship assistance, funeral preparation, etc.)

25-Online Connections: Responsible for online ministries designed to connect and engage with people who are attending online services, groups and/or social media.



Overview

About this Report

The Church Compensation Services 2023 MegaChurch Compensation Survey is the seventeenth annual survey of megachurch pastoral and staff compensation. This year's report includes data for 87 positions in 24 ministries from 134 churches representing 17,513 employees. Data is grouped by weekly church attendance, operating budget, denomination, and region.

Privacy and Confidentiality

All data is kept strictly confidential. It is our policy to comply with all U.S. Department of Justice Safe Harbor Guidelines and antitrust laws as they relate to compensation data. Data is reported in aggregate only when a minimum of 5 organizations are available. The privacy of each church's positional data is critical. Individual church salaries will not be shown in the report under any circumstance. Additionally, data specific to an employee's identity (i.e., name, social security number) is never collected as a part of this survey.

Participation

The availability of data reported for any given position or scope is dependent upon the number of churches participating in this survey. Please encourage comparable size churches in your region and denomination to participate in next year's survey. This will increase sample sizes and availability of data relevant to your church.






